Terms and Conditions

Thanks for your interest in Destination ImagiNation in Clarence. As part of the application process, we want to make sure you and your child fully understand what is expected as a participant in the program. As a member of DI, your child will embark on an unbelievable experience that is team-oriented and challenging. Since all activities are team oriented, it is very important your child is available to meet with his or her team as scheduled. We also ask that you as a parent stay engaged with your child's Team Manager and be a participant in the program and not just a by-stander. This means helping to fundraise, assisting the Team Manager as needed, attending DI parent meetings, and so forth. Below are some points of note for you and your child to review.

For the Student:

_____ I realize that no DI challenge has one single solution and that a successful team cooperates by considering EVERYONES' solution. I will not criticize anyone else's ideas.

_____ I agree that my behavior at meetings will be constructive and positive. I will follow the specific rules that are established by the Team Manager.

_____ I agree that each DI team meeting is valuable and I will attend each meeting. If a conflict arises, I will notify my Team Manager in advance.

_____ I understand that my behavior at DI meetings is the same as is expected at school, no matter where the meeting is being held.

_____ I agree to cooperate on the DI challenge that my team chooses, even if it's not my first choice.

_____ I agree that the solution we develop for the challenge, including props, costumes, signs, script, etc. will be made only by me and the members of my team. I realize that if there is any part of our solution that my team cannot complete without interference, we must redesign that part of the solution.

_____ I understand that the Clarence-DI program recognizes all teams that develop solutions for the DI tournaments/competitions. They are all considered successful. I agree to show other teams my utmost respect, good sportsmanship and support.

For the Parents:

_____ I agree that, in the proper spirit of DI, I will not interfere with the solutions developed by my child's team. All creations, inventions, decorations, ideas, etc., must come from the team members. I understand that I can ask questions, to assist in the thinking process, but I cannot provide any answers or tell them what to do.

_____ I agree to have my child attend each meeting. If there is a scheduling conflict, my child or I will notify the Team Manager in a timely fashion.

_____ I realize that my child's Team Manager will be contributing a significant amount of time and effort to provide a rewarding experience for my child and their team. I will be cooperative and as helpful as possible to support my child's efforts.

_____ I understand that my child has made a commitment to their team. This means being available for important DI events, including:

- _____ Celebration of Creativity
- _____ Regional Tournament
- _____ State Tournament (if the team qualifies)
- _____ Global Tournament (if the team qualifies)

_____ If my child's team plans on going to competition and desires funding from the Clarence DI Boosters, I will be supportive of the fundraising activity that the team chooses to coordinate and/or participate in.

_____ I understand that the DI philosophy is to measure a team's success through the learning experience and accomplishments of the team members – NOT by their competition scores. I will support my child in their DI endeavors and help them focus on making their participation in the DI program be a positive experience.

_____ I understand that my child may be removed from the DI team if he/she consistently violates any section of the student's contract.

Participation Policy:

Student must agree with the following:

- *I have read the Destination Imagination description and understand the time requirements and commitment. I understand how important it is to attend the regular weekly meeting.
- *I understand that if I drop out of DI after my team starts working on the challenge, my team cannot replace me.
- *I understand that my behavior at DI meetings is the same as expected at school, no matter where the meeting is held.
- *I understand that my team managers are volunteering their time so that I can learn new things and that if I am behaving inappropriately they can remove me from the meeting or from the team.

Parents must agree with the following:

- *I have read the Destination Imagination Policy and understand the time requirements.
- *I understand how important it is that my child attends the regular weekly meeting.
- *I understand that I am responsible for my child's transportation after school hours.
- *I understand that team managers are volunteering their time & should not have to bear all financial costs.
- *I understand that if my child is placed on a team there will be a registration fee of \$25.
- *I understand that if my child is placed on a team fundraising participation is expected.
- *I give permission for my child to participate in the Destination Imagination program.
